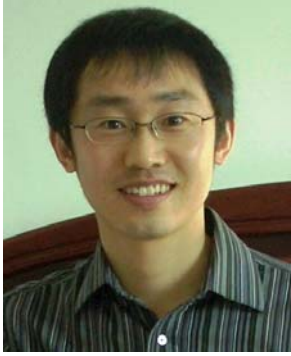


Hou Yongsen (永森)
